With the launch of SmartNews AI Matome, SmartNews will further its efforts to convey information in clearer, more multifaceted ways.

Key Features of SmartNews AI Matome

- Generative AI individually summarizes major articles on the same topic from national newspapers and key TV broadcasters, and compiles them into a single consolidated article.
- At the beginning of each article, three key points are presented: What happened (event); Why it happened (background); and What's next (outlook). Together, these help users understand the overall picture of the news.
- Each summary explicitly cites its source and includes a direct link to the original article, allowing interested users to access the full version with a single tap.

SmartNews Al Matome's Summary Policy and Partner Media

SmartNews AI Matome only summarizes articles from partner media outlets with explicit permission. Summaries are grouped by theme into one article. Importantly, partner media articles are used solely for generating and structuring summaries and will not be used as AI training data.
